



KWICG DELEGATION COACH CODE OF CONDUCT

The goal of the International Children's Games is to enable, develop and advance the meeting, understanding and friendship of students from different countries, and to advance the Olympic ideal.

PREAMBLE:

It is the responsibility of the City of Kitchener, the City of Waterloo, the KWICG and its Delegations to set standards in matter of ethics, sportsmanship, the welfare of the athletes and all matters under its jurisdiction.

All members of the KWICG Delegations will be expected to abide by the following Code of Conduct. Membership may be suspended, terminated, or rejected following appropriate disciplinary procedures. The Code of Conduct is in effect for the entire period of your membership on the delegation.

Everyone signing the Code of Conduct agrees that he/she will abide by it as a member of the KWICG Delegations. Failure to comply may result in disciplinary action as outlined in the Section 5 of the ICG Athlete Agreement.

IN GENERAL:

1. Members shall conduct themselves in a manner which reflects the values and ethics of the City of Kitchener, the City of Waterloo, the KWICG and its Delegations. Coaches will recognize and follow Canadian laws and laws of the Games Host Country and any other country through which the delegation may travel.
2. Orderly and reasonable behaviour is expected while representing the delegation during travel to and from the Games, in the accommodations, at competitions and at all other times.
3. No Member shall act to the detriment of others, City of Kitchener, City of Waterloo, the KWICG and its Delegations, or the International Children's Games in a situation where the responsibility of their position places them in a conflict of interest.
4. Members should be trustworthy, exhibit honesty, sportsmanship, loyalty and discretion when representing themselves, their city and their club when they participate in activities of the delegation, and when they travel to and from the ICG with the delegation.

IN ALL INSTANCES:

Members should consider it their responsibility to report any behaviour that does not follow the Code of Conduct to the Head of Delegation.
